

9 Questions to Ask Before You Enrol Your Child in French

Take this with you. Ask every institute the same nine.

1. How many students in the batch? What age range?			
2. Is speaking time scheduled, or only if time allows?			
3. Can the teacher demonstrate pronunciation, or only explain grammar?			
4. Do you follow the school syllabus, CEFR levels, or both?			
5. How is progress reported — marks, or level?			
6. What happens if my child misses classes?			
7. Are materials included in the fee?			
8. Is there a free demo class?			
9. What do you do for a child who is shy about speaking?			

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Question 1. A batch mixing a ten-year-old with an adult is working at the wrong pace for both.

Question 2. “If we have time” means no.

Question 3. A teacher who cannot say the words cannot fix your child's pronunciation.

Question 9. This is the one that separates a good class from an average one. Every batch has a quiet child. What happens to that child is the whole question.

Your child can score 90 in the French board exam and still not speak a sentence. In the CBSE paper, **0 of 80 written marks test speaking.** In ICSE, speaking is worth **5 marks out of 100.** That is not your child's fault and usually not the school's either.
